

Things to know for the day of the study

Things to remember to bring:

- Two-piece pajamas or loose-fitting clothing (example: shorts and t-shirt—for long sleeve-make sure they are loose at your wrists and ankles). Female patients—nightgowns/nightshirts require bottoms underneath!
- Overnight bag with toiletries, change of clothes (if desired)
- Your insurance card and photo ID
- If you prefer your own pillow(s)—we suggest colored/patterned pillow case(s)
- MASKS are Required for all patients coming into the lab

Things to keep in mind for the day of your study:

- No caffeinated beverages after lunch
- No hair products in hair such as hairspray, mouse, gel, etc.
- No dark colored nail polish--one finger is needed to be free of polish (sometimes darker colors interfere with the pulse oximetry)
- Refrain from any naps during the day
- NO NUT products are allowed in the facility! (Due to Covid-19, the facility no longer offers breakfast in the mornings—you may bring small snacks—if needed). No dinner provided—please eat at home before coming in!
